Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to provide a quick Covid-19 update. As you are probably aware, in recent days there have been some Covid-19 cases linked to the Don KR factory in Castlemaine. I have been in close contact with the Department of Education and Training (DET) to ensure that we continue to respond to this situation in accordance with the expert advice the DET is receiving from the Victorian Chief Health Officer.

Based on this advice, our school remains open with all DET recommended hygiene measures in place. I have explained these hygiene and safety measures in previous correspondence over the past few months, and we will summarise this information, along with new steps we have recently implemented, for publication on the CSC website this afternoon. Again, I take this opportunity to remind all CSC students and staff not to attend school if you are unwell. Similarly, it is essential that any staff or students who have been in contact with a suspected case of Covid-19 to self-isolate, get tested and remain at home until medical clearance is received to return to school.
